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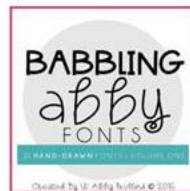

SET UP AND SUPPLY LIST:

For Nature Hunt Activity:

1. Give each child a paper bag.
2. Give each of them a collection bag cover to either get stapled or glued on the outside of the bag.
3. Remind them that you collect items from the ground not off of a living organism. Review if needed. (living vs. nonliving)
4. Give each child a scavenger hunt collection list. to glue onto the other side of the bag. Spend time collecting items that are on the list. Set up a meeting place or walk as a group. They can check off the list as they go.

For Leaf Observations:

1. Give each child a leaf or have them use their collected leaves.
2. Go through the sheet and what needs to be filled out. (differentiated)
3. Give them time to work on the sheet.
4. As a group discussed observations.
5. Create an anchor chart before or after this activity.
